IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL CUSTOMERS

ILMU/PMA West Coast Contract Negotiations – Further Update

Dear Valued Client,

ADM Global wishes to provide further updates to the severe port congestion on the West Coast of the United States.

Please note the situation on the West Coast of the United States is continuing to deteriorate. The Pacific Maritime Association said it will suspend vessel operations at West Coast port terminals on four of the next five days, rather than pay premium salaries to members of the International Longshore and Warehouse Union. The four dates affected by the suspension of vessel operations are Thursday, 2/12 (Lincoln's Birthday); Saturday, 2/14; Sunday, 2/15; and Monday, 2/16 (Washington's Birthday). PMA spokesman Wade Gates said the longshoremen are continuing slowdowns "that will soon bring West Coast ports to gridlock. What they're doing amounts to a strike with pay, and we will reduce the extent to which we pay premium rates for such a strike."

ADM Global will continue to monitor the situation and provide updates as the negotiations progress over the coming days.
